St. Peter's High School, Gloucester



Following on from its successful management of an internal refurbishment project at St Peter's High School Sixth Form Centre, Hookway has recently overseen a significant heating project at the school.

Valued at approximately £1.2 million, the project spanned several months and involved the removal of outdated chimneys and gas heating systems, and the installation of new air source heat pumps.

Ensuring reliable heating in a school environment is crucial, as heating failures can lead to significant disruptions, including school closures. Such interruptions not only affect the daily operations of the school but also hinder students' learning and well-being. The installation of this new heating system was therefore meticulously planned and executed to minimise any impact on the children's education and to maintain a comfortable environment which was conducive to learning.
